RIGHT of the Flora and Fauna to live without fear of extinction as a result of human actions ● Right to freedom (every animal species has the right to live in freedom) ● Right not to be killed to feed nor “amuse” humans (reduce the meat consumption, forbid the use of animals in circuses, no animals treated in an undignified manner, overcrowded, and over exploited...) ● Right for the animals and plants to live in a healthy environment and not be exploited ● Right to be loved ● Right for all the endangered species to be defended ● Right for animals and plants to live in their natural habitat, without being displaced to other places ● Right for animals and plants to be protected from human interests ● Right for every single animal to live in its natural habitat without human interference ● Right to create new animal species

rights of the WATER

RIGHT for seas, lakes and rivers to be clean ● Right for the oceans and seas to be free from plastics, pollution and chemical waste ● Right not to be contaminated with chemical substances ● Right to be abundant for everyone ● Right for rivers to flow freely and maintain their natural cycles

RIGHT to have natural resources safeguarded ● Right to preserve natural resources, converting the three Rs (recycling, reuse, reduce) into habits of the entire (human) population, especially that of Reduce ● Right not to be over-exploited (conscious use of the natural resources) ● Right to increase the use of renewable energies ● Right to a clean environment (Right not to litter the Earth surface) ● Right to a healthy and sustainable “diet”; this means Right to have a sustainable agriculture (no GMO products/seeds in it ● Right to have respectful residents (human beings reducing their environmental imprint) ● Right not to be attacked by waste ● Right to sustainable consumption and exploitation ● Right to respect and protect (bio)diversity ● Right to maintain its integrity despite conflicts provoked by human beings ● Right to life, to guarantee a healthy life to it and all its inhabitants ● Right to prevent ecological imbalance in ecosystems ● Right to keep the wooded mass protected from indiscriminate taxation, arson or the transformation of forests into grazing land for cattle ● Right to maintain the environment with an adequate noise level, avoiding noise pollution ● Right to have plants respected, as a source of oxygen and food ● Right to be free from exploitation of its natural resources ● Right to be free from climate change caused by humans ● Right to be treated with respect and care by all living beings ● Right to be free from the negative impact of human development ● Right to be free from deforestation and habitat destruction ● Right to be free from nuclear weapons and other destructive technology ● Right to be free from the negative impact of tourism ● Right to be free from human infrastructural projects ● Right to be at peace ● Right to maintain vital processes ● Right to exist unbothered by humans ● Right to maintain the balance that supports all life ● Right to naturally evolve without human-caused disruption ● Right to protect its natural habitats ● Right to create new landscapes ● Right to be independent without human help ● Right to exist ● Right to have mountains and plants on it ● Right to live free from cruel treatment ● Right to preserve its resources ● Right to be treated fairly ● Right to be protected ● Right not to be destroyed ● Right to have life on it ● Right not to be harmed ● Right to stay green ● Right to have vegetation ● Right to preserve tropical forests ● Rights for ecosystems to exist and thrive ● Right to preserve the Arctic and Antarctic untouched ● Right to preserve mushrooms, plants and microorganisms untouched ● Right to regenerate ● Right for native trees and forests to grow freely ● Right to be angry with people ● Right to evolve in its own time ● Right to preserve a healthy and sustainable planet for future generations to inherit ● Right to protect and preserve its traditional land and culture for indigenous people ● Right to be respected and protected as a whole as an interconnected living system ● Right for coral reefs to be untouchable
