BACKGROUND



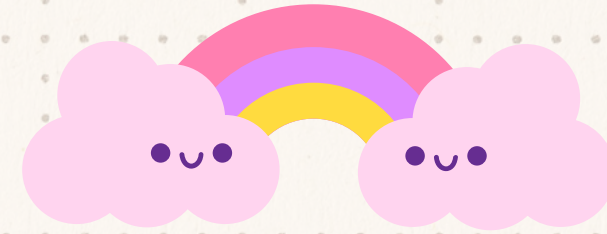
Today we produce twice as much plastic waste as two decades ago.

Only about one tenth of plastic waste is successfully recycled.

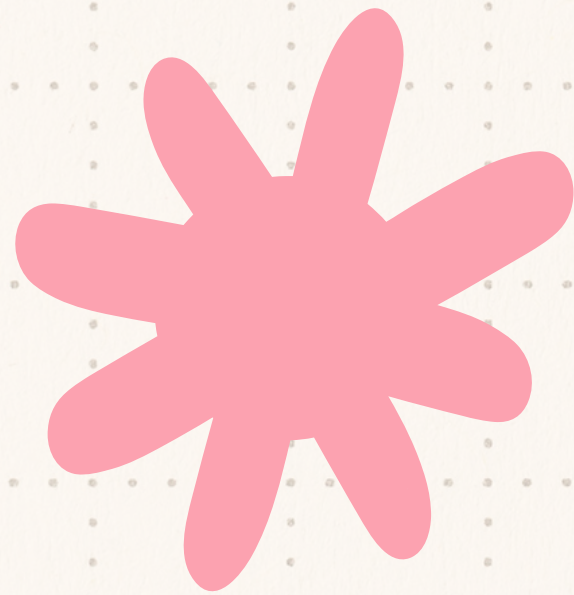
Two thirds of plastic waste consist of plastics that are used for less than five years.

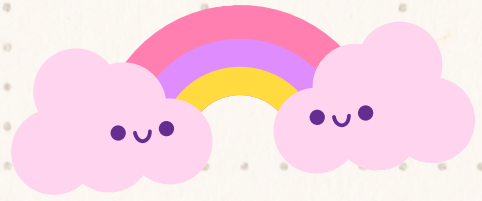
